Updates and changes with the RELAP5-3D code, team, and the International RELAP5 User Group.

1. License/IRUG Membership Fee Increase

In order to maintain our high level of service, support, and continued software development such as the release of RELAP5-3D Version 4.4.2, which will take place in May 2018, a rate increase is needed. This increase is needed merely to keep up with inflation.

4. Version 4.4.2 Release Date

A preliminary INTERNAL version of RELAP5-3D has been created and testing on Linux and Windows platforms has begun. Issues identified by the standard installation process have already been corrected. Preliminary INTERNAL versions of the IRUG executable and IRUG source distributions have been created. The full battery of testing will take place over the next weeks.

Due to staffing changes, the version will be delayed beyond the 2018 IRUG Seminar and Business Meeting of April 30 - May 4. The expected PUBLIC release date is June 1, 2018.
